- Using Indexing, Offline Vault, and Outlook Web Access (OWA)
- Enterprise Vault Backup

Do beta candidates need to be an expert to take the beta exam?

No, we seek 100+ candidates with various knowledge, skill, and experience to take the beta exam. During the beta exam, Symantec seeks all candidates who are interested. This includes candidates who are considered above qualified, below qualified, and minimally qualified.

What's in it for you when you become a BETA candidate?

- There is an opportunity to view the exams in their entirety and to comment on each of the questions.
- Beta exams are offered at a discounted price, \$75 US.
- Those with passing scores will become certified in the same way as the final version of the exam and will receive a special certificate with the words "Beta Exam" in a gold embossed stamp.
