We also recommend you run the Symantec Endpoint Protection agent on clients that connect to the Microsoft Windows Small Business Server.</p> <p>In the case of Microsoft Windows Essential Business Server, you can run the Symantec Endpoint Protection management console on either the Microsoft Windows Essential Business Server Management Server or the Microsoft Windows Essential Business Server Security Server. We also recommend that you run the Symantec Endpoint Protection agent on clients that connect to the Microsoft Windows Essential Business Server servers.</p>
